Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon
Thursday June 29th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather, boiling. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and cloudy at daylight hove up anchor and started for White Patch

Friday June 30th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and cloudy weather. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy steering down the coast, employed in stowing down oil

Saturday July 1st

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather steering down the coast. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze lowered 4 boats, the Starboard boat struck a whale.

Sunday July 2nd

First part commenced with moderate breeze. Killed the whale and took him alongside and after dinner cut him in at sundown anchored at White Patch. Middle part raining. Latter part cloudy lowered 2 boats. employed in cutting up blubber at 11 hove up anchor.

Monday July 3rd

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather started the works at 5 anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats at 10 & finished boiling

Humpbacking off White Patch
Tuesday July 4th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Wednesday July 5th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 4 boats

Thursday July 6th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and raining hove up anchor and lowered 4 boats the Starboard boat got a last year's calf.

Friday July 7th

First part commenced with fresh breeze. the Waist Boat got a whale, cut him in and anchored a little after dark. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats, cut the blubber up and started the works.

Saturday July 8th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear, boiling. Anchored and called the boats on board. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze lowered 2 boats finished boiling and stowed down some oil
