Remarks on board Cape Horn Vizion
Tuesday July 18th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather, boiling. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze, hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats finished boiling.

Wednesday July 19th

First part commenced with moderate breeze at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Thursday July 20th

First part commenced with fresh breeze at 2 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Friday July 21st

First part fresh breeze they Starboard Boat struck a Whale and took him at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Saturday July 22nd

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats. the Starboard boat struck and killed a Whale, took him alongside at 11 O'clock.

Humpbacking at White Patch
Sunday July 23rd

First part commenced with moderate breeze and cloudy weather, cut the Whale in and anchored and cut up some of the blubber. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze and cloudy hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats. started the works.

Monday July 24th

First part commenced with moderate breeze at 5 P.M. anchored, commenced with the Athlboro. Middle part boiling. Latter part hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats finished boiling.

Tuesday July 25th

First part commenced with fresh breeze at 6 P.M. anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze, hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Wednesday July 26th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. Lowered 2 boats employed in storing down oil.

Thursday July 27th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather, finished storing down oil. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.
