Remarks on Log of Cape Horn Region
Wednesday Aug 16th

First part commences with strong breeze, at 11 P.M. anchored and took up the boats. Middle part boiling. Latter part moderate breeze lowered 2 boats, got some plantains from shore.

Thursday Aug 17th

First part commences with moderate breeze, employed in boiling. Middle part fresh breeze, finished boiling. Latter part moderate breeze lowered 2 boats, stowed down some oil, got some punkins from shore.

Friday Aug 18th

First part commences with moderate breeze, stowing down oil. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze, hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Saturday Aug 19th

First part commences with fresh breeze, at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze, hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats. broke the second Master Brackett and put in another man.

Sunday Aug 20th

First part commences with fresh breeze, the Starboard Boat struck and killed a cow and calf got her alongside at 7 P.M. anchored at 11 P.M. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part moderate breeze, cut the Whale in and hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats.

Whaling off White Patch
Monday Aug 21st

First part commences with fresh breeze, cut up the blubber and started the works anchored at 5 P.M. Middle part raining. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats.

Tuesday Aug 22nd

First part commences with fresh breeze, boiling, at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze, finished boiling. Latter part moderate breeze, hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats.

Wednesday Aug 23rd

First part commences with fresh breeze, at 2 P.M. anchored and took a raft of casks ashore. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze, stowed down oil.

Thursday Aug 24th

First part commences with fresh breeze, filled the casks with water but could not bring them off it was too rough. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze, got off the raft of water.

Friday Aug 25th

First part commences with fresh breeze, hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats, at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and foggy, hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.
