Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon

Saturday Aug 26th

First part commences with fresh breeze at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Sunday Aug 27th

First part commences with fresh breeze and cloudy weather at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Monday Aug 28th

First part commences with fresh breeze the Starboard Boat struck a Whale but the iron came out and lost him, anchored at 5 P.M. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and clear hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Tuesday Aug 29th

First part commences with fresh breeze and cloudy weather anchored at 5 P.M. Middle part rainy. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats, got a boat load of pumpkins from shore.

Wednesday Aug 30th

First part commences with moderate breeze at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Thursday Aug 31st

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather. Took Mr. Kimball's Boatstewer and put another man in. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze lowered 2 boats.

Friday Sep 1st

First part commences with fresh breeze and cloudy weather at night the boats went on board. Middle part fresh breeze heaving to the windward. Latter part moderate breeze lowered 2 boats the Bow Boat struck and killed a cow and calf, got her alongside at 12.

Saturday Sep 2nd

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather cut the Whale in and cut the flubber up. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part moderate breeze started the works lowered 2 boats.

Sunday Sep 3rd

First part commences with strong breeze and clear weather, boiling, at 5 P.M. anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Monday Sep 4th

First part commences with fresh breeze at 12 called the boats on board. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze sent the main sail.
