Thursday Dec 7th

These 24 hours moderate breezes and
pleasant weather employed in different pts.

Friday Dec 8th
These 24 hours light breezes and pleasant
weather

Saturday Dec 9th
First part commences with light breeze
and pleasant weather at 4 P.M. weighed
Anchor and left Panama. Middle part
fresh breeze from N. steering S by W.
Latter part fresh breeze employed in
various pts. sent the new Main top Gallant sail.

Sunday Dec 10th
First part commences with light breeze
and pleasant weather from N. steering
S. Middle part squally. Latter part
raining with a heavy swell from S.W.

Monday Dec 11th
First part commences with a calm
and rainy. Middle part fresh breeze
from S.W. Latter part fresh breeze and
cloudy made new pipes for the tryworks

Tuesday Dec 12th
First part commences with fresh breeze
from S.W. heading S. Middle part
fresh breeze more ship. Latter part moderate
breeze more ship and made all sail.
setting up shooks

Beating up the Coast
Wednesday Dec 13th

First part commences with moderate
breeze and cloudy weather employed in
setting up shooks &c. saw the Island of Oryzoma.
Middle part strong breeze standing off shore.
Latter part fresh breeze heading in shore.

Thursday Dec 14th
First part commences with fresh breeze and
clear weather setting up shooks. coiled some
new Whaletines. Middle part fresh breeze.
Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy.

Friday Dec 15th
First part commences with fresh breeze and
clear weather. Middle part fresh breeze
Latter part fresh breeze heading W. by N.

Saturday Dec 16th
First part commences with squally weather.
Middle part rainy. Latter part fresh breeze.

Sunday Dec 17th
First part commences with fresh breeze
from S.W. heading S.W. Oryzoma in sight.
Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh
breeze and squally. Saw a sperm Whale
going to the windward. got the boats ready and
it rained for 2 or 3 hours and we never saw
him again
