Remarks on board Cape Horn Pigeon
Monday Dec 18th

First part commenced with fresh breeze
and dark, cloudy weather. At 4 P.M.
tacked. Sailed off shore, the land about
5 miles off. Middle part fresh breeze
 Latter part moderate breeze and clear.

Tuesday Dec 19th

First part commenced with moderate
breeze and pleasant weather land in
sight. Sent a new Main top sail.
Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part
moderate breeze and clear sent a new
Flying jib.

Wednesday Dec 20th

First part commenced with fresh breeze
and clear weather. Beating up the Coast
land in sight. Middle part fresh breeze
 Latter part fresh breeze.

Thursday Dec 21st

First part commenced with moderate breeze
and clear weather. Middle part fresh breeze
 Latter part moderate breeze. took out the
Port pump and calked some cracks and
put it back again.

Friday Dec 22nd

First part commenced with fresh breeze
and clear weather. Middle part fresh
breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and clear

Saturday Dec 23rd

First part commenced with strong breeze and
cloudy weather. southerly reefed the top sails and
furlled the jib and spanker. Middle part fresh
breeze. Latter part moderate breeze.

Sunday Dec 24th

First part commenced with moderate
breeze and clear weather, at dark anchored
at Macanao. Middle part calm. Latter
part moderate breeze.

Monday Dec 25th

First part commenced with fresh and
clear weather. Middle part calm. Latter
part light breeze. beating off wood. sent a
new fore top sail and aft top sail.

Tuesday Dec 26th

First part commenced with fresh breeze
and pleasant weather beating off wood.
Middle part light breeze. Latter part light
breeze and clear beating off wood. repaired
the fore top gallant sail.

Wednesday Dec 27th

First part commenced with fresh breeze
and clear weather beating off wood.
Middle part light breeze. Latter part
moderate breeze
