Remarks on Logrol Cape Horn Pigeon
Wednesday Apr 3rd
First part commences with light breeze and
pleasant weather from S steering N 6 by E.
Middle part calm. Latter part calm.

Thursday Apr 4th
First part commences with light airs
from S. Middle part calm. Latter
part calm.

Friday Apr 5th
First part commences with a squall
from N. Middle part light breeze. Latter
part light breeze steering E by N.

Saturday Apr 6th
First part commences with light breeze
from WNW at 3 P.M. raised sperm whales
4 miles off. Landed the boats and pulled
for them. the Starboard Boat, and Waist Boat,
and Bow Boat, each struck a whale. the Waist
Boat got stove and the Starboard Boat had
to go and pick him up. lost the whale saved
the other two. got them alongside just after
dark. Middle part light breeze. Latter part
moderate breeze. cut the whales in.

Sunday Apr 7th
First part commences with moderate breeze
from W sailed the cases and cut the blubber
up. started the works. Middle part boiling.
Latter part some rain.

Sperm Whaling
Monday Apr 9th

First part commences with light-airs
from W. boiling. at dark commenced to
rain cooled down the works. Middle part
light breeze. Latter part light breeze started the
works and finished boiling.

Tuesday Apr 10th
First part commences with light breeze and
pleasant weather from E. Middle part light
breeze. Latter part light breeze from E.

Wednesday Apr 11th
First part commences with light breeze
and pleasant weather. Middle part calm.
Latter part calm stored down the oil.

Thursday Apr 12th
First part commences with a calm. Middle
part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze.

Friday Apr 13th
First part commences with fresh breeze and
pleasant weather from S. Middle part calm.
Latter part moderate breeze from S. heading
S.

Saturday Apr 14th
First part commences with moderate breeze
and clear weather from E heading S. Middle
part calm. Latter part light airs.
