Remarks on Log of Cape Horn Vign

Sunday May 13th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather heading E.S.E. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and clear.

Monday May 14th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather heading E.S.E. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. at 11 A.M. anchored at Point Belera to fix the ship.

Tuesday May 15th

First part commenced with moderate breeze. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. employed in breaking out the fore hole to raise her bow out of water all we could. filled the fore hold of salt water to put her stern down. tried to fix one of the leaks but it was too rugged and had to stop for the day.

Wednesday May 16th

First part commenced with cloudy weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze fixed the Port bow and it came on rugged and we had to stop.

Thursday May 17th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze fixed the Starboard Bow and commenced to stow off the hole again.

Friday May 18th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather finished stowing off the hole. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. at 6 A.M. made sail and took our anchor and went to sea.

Saturday May 19th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather heading S. Middle part light breeze gave ship to the W. Latter part moderate breeze.

Sunday May 20th

First part commenced with fresh breeze from S.W. heading W. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze heading S.E.

Monday May 21st

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather from S.W. heading S.E. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part the same.

Tuesday May 22nd

First part commenced with fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.E. land in sight at dark gave ship. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze.

Wednesday May 23rd

First part commenced with fresh breeze. Manta in sight. jammed with the Gay Head. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze.
