Remarks on Board Cape Horn Vign

Thursday May 25th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze.

Friday May 26th

First part commenced with fresh breeze. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy.

Saturday May 27th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy weather. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part the same.

Sunday May 28th

First part commenced with fresh breeze heading S.E. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part calm.

Monday May 29th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather at 5 P.M. Anchored at Lumbay. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze. At daylight we found that we were to the South of Lumbay. Hoisted up anchor and went in and anchored again.

Tuesday May 30th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather. Unbent the new sails and bent the old ones. Got a raft of casks ready to go ashore. Middle part light breeze. Latter part the same took the casks up the river to fill the "Gay Head" Anchored.

Wednesday May 31st

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather. Filled the casks and got them about half way down the river and they grounded had to anchor them for the night. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze got the casks on board the ship.

Thursday May 31st

First part moderate breeze and pleasant weather stowed the water below. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze the Starboard Watch went ashore on liberty employed in taring the rigging.

Friday June 1st

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather. Starboard Watch ashore. Middle part light breeze. Latter part the same.

Saturday June 2nd

First part moderate breeze and pleasant weather. Starboard Watch came on board and Port Watch went ashore. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze.

Sunday June 3rd

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze.

Monday June 4th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather. Port Watch came on board again. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. Taring the rigging.
