Remarks on board Cape Horn Tigon

Saturday June 16th

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather. the Starboard Boat struck a Whale and the line parted and we kept going at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze at daylight hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Sunday June 17th

First part commences with light breeze at sundown anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze at daylight hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats. took the Waist Boat in and put her on the house and put another boat out. the Bow Boat struck a Cow and lost years calf. Killed them and took them alongside. anchored and got dinner.

Monday June 18th

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather cut the Whales in and cut up some of the flubber. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze at daylight hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats. finished cutting up the flubber.

Tuesday June 19th

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather at 4 PM anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze at daylight hove up anchor and lowered 2 boats.

Humpbacking

Wednesday June 20th

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather at night anchored. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze lowered 2 boats finished hilling.

Thursday June 21st

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather at night the boats came on board. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze at daylight lowered 2 boats employed in stowing down till.

Friday June 22nd

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and hazy at daylight hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Saturday June 23rd

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather at night anchored. the Waist Boat struck a Whale and got rolled over and lost him. Middle part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Sunday June 24th

First part commences with fresh breeze. the Starboard Boat struck a Whale and got stove and lost him. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze at daylight hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.
