

Remarks on Board Cape Horn Pigeon  
Wednesday July 25<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather the Waist Boat got a calf years calf. cut him in and anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and started the works.

Thursday July 26<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather the Starboard Boat struck and killed a Whale, took him alongside and cut him in. at sundown anchored, coiled the works down and started them again. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Friday July 27<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze, finished stripping, at night anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Saturday July 28<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze the Starboard Boat struck a Whale and the iron broke and lost him. the Waist Boat struck another and parted the line and lost him. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats. bent another Mizzen Topmast Stay Sail. the Starboard Boat struck and killed a Whale, took him alongside and anchored.

Stumpbacking at Santa Clara  
Sunday July 29<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather, cut the Whale in and cut up some of the blubber. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part light breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats, started the works.

Monday July 30<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze and cloudy weather at dark anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Tuesday July 31<sup>st</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze at night anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze. lowered 2 boats, stowed down oil.

Wednesday Aug 1<sup>st</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze, finished stowing down oil. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.

Thursday Aug 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather. the Starboard Boat struck a Whale but could not haul to him and had to cut line. the Bow Boat struck another Whale and his iron came out and lost him, at night anchored. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze hove up anchor and lowered 3 boats.
