Monday Nov 17th

These 24 hours light breeze and pleasant weather Starboard Watch came on board

Tuesday Nov 18th

These 24 hours light breeze and pleasant weather employed in bringing off men and things from shore. 11 men shipped and came on board.

Wednesday Nov 19th

These 24 hours light breeze and clear weather

Thursday Nov 20th

First part commences with light breeze from NW at 1/2 P.M. the Capt came on board, hove up anchor and made sail and went to sea steering S. Middle part fresh breeze Latter part fresh breeze.

Friday Nov 21st

First part commences with fresh breeze and a heavy swell heading S by E. Middle part fresh breeze Latter part fresh breeze and raining.

Saturday Nov 22nd

First part commences with squally weather and heavy rain. Middle part rainy. Latter part calm with heavy rain.

Sunday Nov 23rd

First part commences with light breeze and raining. Middle part rainy. Latter part the same

Monday Nov 26th

First part commences with light airs and calms. Middle part calm. Latter part equally and some new running rigging.

Tuesday Nov 27th

First part commences with fresh squalls from NW steering SW. Middle part light breeze Latter part moderate breeze with some rain.

Wednesday Nov 28th

First part commences with light breeze and cloudy weather from W heading S by W. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light airs and raining.

Thursday Nov 29th

First part commences with light breeze from W heading S by W. Middle part calm. Latter part light airs.

Friday Nov 30th

First part commences with light breeze from NW. Middle part light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze heading S by E land in sight

Saturday Dec 1st

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather at dark tacked ship off shore. Middle part fresh breeze tacked ship. Latter part moderate breeze and rain.

Sunday Dec 2nd

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part moderate breeze
