Monday Mar 24<sup>th</sup>

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from ESE heading NE. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part the same.

Tuesday Mar 25<sup>th</sup>

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from ESE steering NE. Middle part the same. Latter part light breeze. Saw several sail.

Wednesday Mar 26<sup>th</sup>

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from SE steering NE. Middle part rainy. Latter part moderate breeze.

Thursday Mar 27<sup>th</sup>

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from ESE heading NE. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part light breeze.

Friday Mar 28<sup>th</sup>

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from ESE steering NE by N. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part fresh breeze.

Saturday Mar 29<sup>th</sup>

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather from ESE steering NE by N. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part equally

Sunday Mar 30<sup>th</sup>

First part commences with strong breeze and equally weather from ESE heading NE. Middle part blowing strong. Latter part moderate breeze.

Monday Mar 31<sup>st</sup>

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather from ESE heading NE. Middle part moderate. Latter part moderate breeze and clear at 6 AM raised. Spum Whale going quick to the windward. Over the boats and pulled for them. The Starboard boat struck one and killed him. The bow boat struck but the horn came out and lost him.

Tuesday Apr 1<sup>st</sup>

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather at 2 PM took the whale alongside. got ready and cut him in. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate breeze and clear. cut the blubber up and started the works.

Wednesday Apr 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from ESE heading NE. boiling. Middle part moderate finished boiling. Latter part fresh breeze.

Thursday Apr 3<sup>rd</sup>

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather from SE steering NE. Middle part fresh. Latter part moderate stowed down the oil
