Remarks on Board Cape Horn Vessel
Wednesday Apr 16th

First part commences with strong breeze and clear weather from E heading N.W. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part strong breeze

Thursday Apr 17th

First part commences with fresh breeze and cloudy weather from E heading N. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh now ship to the S.E.

Friday Apr 18th

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather from E heading S.E. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate repaired the fore sail.

Saturday Apr 19th

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather from E heading N.W. Middle part by the wind. Latter part moderate breeze steering N.

Sunday Apr 20th

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E heading N.W. at dark took in sail and luffed by the wind. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate steering N.

Monday Apr 21st

First part commences with moderate breeze and clear weather from E heading N.W. Middle part moderate. Latter part the same steering N.W.

Home ward Bound.

Tuesday Apr 22nd

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E heading S.W. at sundown took in sail. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh.

Wednesday Apr 23rd

First part commences with fresh breeze and clear weather from E heading N.W. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part moderate breeze. saw a Whale whaling. raised a dead Whale and lowered the Larboard Boat and took him alongside he was much flustered being dead four days.

Thursday Apr 24th

First part commences with moderate breeze and pleasant weather cut the Whale in and cut the flubber up. spoke the Pioneer cutting. the Capt went on board a few minutes. at dark started the work. Middle part moderate finished sailing. Latter part moderate breeze.

Friday Apr 25th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather. Pioneer in sight. at sundown took in sail. Middle part calm. Latter part light air.

Saturday Apr 26th

First part commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from E. at sundown took in sail. Middle part light breeze. Latter part the same.
