Remarks on Board Cape Horn Steamer

Sunday Apr 27th

First part commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather from E. at sundown took in Sail. Middle part light. Latter part moderate.

Monday Apr 28th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather, commenced with the Pinna Capt Chase. Middle part moderate. Latter part the same.

Tuesday Apr 29th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather at sundown took in Sail. Middle part moderate. Latter part moderate steering NW.

Wednesday Apr 30th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather steering NW at sundown luffed by the wind. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh, at 8 AM raised Spinn Whelw. lowered the boats and the Bow Boat and Waist Boat each got a Whale at 11 AM took them alongside.

Thursday May 1st

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather. cut the Whelw in and got supper. Middle part fresh. Latter part fresh. Sailing.

Homeward Bound

Friday May 2nd

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather. Sailing. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh at 12 finished sailing.

Saturday May 3rd

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather. Middle part fresh. Latter part fresh and clear.

Sunday May 4th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from E heading SE. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part moderate breeze 1 Sail in sight.

Monday May 5th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from ENE heading SE. Middle part moderate. Latter part light breeze stored down sail.

Tuesday May 6th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E. Middle part moderate. Latter part the same heading S.W.

Wednesday May 7th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E heading N.W. Middle part moderate breeze. Latter part moderate
