Remarks on Voyage Cape Horn Paper

Thursday May 8th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from E heading S by E. Middle part fresh. Latter part fresh breeze heading NNE.

Friday May 9th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from E heading NNE. Middle part fresh. Latter part fresh breeze steering WNW.

Saturday May 10th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from E steering N by W at sundown took in sail and luffed by the wind. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh steering WNW.

Sunday May 11th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from E steering N by E. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze steering WNW.

Monday May 12th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from E steering WNW. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh steering NW.

Tuesday May 13th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from E steering N by N. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part the same.

Homeward Bound

Wednesday May 14th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from E steering N by S. Middle part equally. Latter part moderate.

Thursday May 15th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from ENE steering N by WNW. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh.

Friday May 16th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from E steering N by WNW at sundown saw a white water. Took in sail and luffed by the wind. Middle part wore ship. at daylight wore ship again. Latter part fresh breeze saw 2 Humpbacks.

Saturday May 17th

First part commenced with fresh breeze from E steering N by WNW. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh and clear.

Sunday May 18th

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from E steering N. Middle part moderate breeze steering NW. Latter part equally.

Monday May 19th

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from SE steering NW. Middle part moderate. Latter part the same saw 1 sail
