Thursday December 6 First part of these day strong breezes from the Southeast and cloudy weather, vessel under main try sail fore sail and jib, tacking to the windward on Starboard tack, at 11^h A.M. were ship on Port tack, at 1^h P.M. the weather clear up and wind moderate we set main sail on first reef, the crew wash the vessel in side pump attended to

Friday December 7 First part of these strong Southeast wind and rough sea with squally, vessel under shorting sails tacking to the windward, on Port tack, this day we brockout Flour, Sugar and Melasses, vessel sucking much water on deck pump attended to

Saturday December 8 First part of these day strong breezes from the Southeast and squally vessel under reef main sail fore sail and head sail, heading S.E. on Port tack, at 4^h P.M. moderate wind we shake reef out main sail, pump attended to

Sunday December 9 First part of these day fresh breezes from the Northeast and squally weather, vessel under reef main sail fore sail and jib steering S.E. on Port tack pump attended to

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Monday December 10 First part of these day strong breezes from the Northeast and rain squally, vessel under main try sail fore sail and jib, steering S.E. on Port tack, vessel shipped much water on deck pump attended to

Tuesday December 11 First part of these day very strong breezes from the Northeast with rain, from passing cloud, vessel under, double reef main sail and fore sail and jib, heading S.E. on Port tack, vessel sucking much water on deck pump attended to

Wednesday December 12 First part of these day strong breezes from the head and squally with rough sea, on vessel under reef main sail and fore sail, standing to the windward on Port tack, pump carefully attended

Thursday December 13 First part of these day, very strong wind from the head with squally and rough sea, on vessel under reef down, the buls stay part and we splaved, and set up, vessel shipping much water on deck pump carefully attended
