Saturday December 15 First part of this day light breezes from the Southeast and foggy weather vessel under all sails set heading E. N. E. on Starboard tack, at 1:30 P.M. we were ship on Port tack, heading S. E. East, crew making senet, we bro out pork, pump attended to.

Sunday December 16 First part of this day very light breezes from the Southeast and foggy weather, vessel under all sails set heading East on Starboard tack.

Monday December 17 First part of this day comes in with light breezes from the South West and foggy vessel under all sails set bellying to the windward these day we paint the vessel in side

Lat 21° 20' Long 26° 3'

Tuesday December 18 First part of this day very light breezes the South West, and foggy weather, vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading South at 3: P.M. wind hauled up to the N.W. we steer S.W. by W. crew making senet

Lat 20° 26' Long 25° 32'

Wednesday December 19 First part of this day very light breezes from the North West and clear weather vessel under all sails set, on Starboard tack, steering S.W. by W.  
pump attended to Lat 19° 23' Long 25° 4'

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Thursday December 20 First part of this day very light breezes from the North West and cloudy weather vessel under all sails set running off, and steering S.W. by W. at 10: A.M. we raised a school of small whale, we lower one boat and we catch one young Bull, we take this whale along side at 12 clock and we put gear up - and commence cut in whale. at 6: clock P.M. we finish cut in whale and we clear up the head, and we took in mainsail and set watch, pump attended to  
Lat 18° 55' Long 25° 09'

Friday December 21 First part of this day dead calm all day vessel under main top sail and jib, at 1: P.M. we start the fire, pump attended to  
Lat 18° 43' Long 25° 12'

Saturday December 22 First part of this day very light breezes from the Southeast and clear weather vessel under main sail and head sails, boiling and steering S.W. by W. at 6: P.M. we finish boiling, pump attended to  
Lat 18° 32' Long 25° 19' W.

Sunday December 23 First part of this day light breezes from the East and cloudy weather vessel under all sails set steering S.W. by W. at 10: clock A.M. we sighted a schooner about 10 miles off. this day we stow down the oil 25 barrels pump attended to we wash the vessel in side and stow off the hole,
