Monday January 28 First part of these day strong breezes from the trade and clear weather vessel under shorting sails - standing to the windward crew making Sennet pump attended to - No observation sun obscure

Tuesday January 29 First part of these day fresh breezes from the trade with rain all day vessel under main try sail fore sail and head sails on Starboard tack at 10: A.M. we sighted a Whaling Schooner to the leeward supposed to be "John Manta" at 6: P.M. we took in fore sails set fore try sail pump attended to - No observation sun obscure

Wednesday January 30 First part of these day strong breezes from the trade and foggy weather in morning we set fore sail standing to the windward on Starboard tack, crew wash the vessel in sight at 4: P.M. we were rounded on Port tack at 6: we took in fore sails and set fore try sails, pump attended to - No observation sun obscure

Thursday January 31 First part of these day fresh breezes from the trade and foggy - in morning we made all sail on Port tack "John Manta" in sight at 10: A.M. the "Manta" went out of sight - this day we made new platform for try work, saw lots of porpoises we catch one, at sun set we shorting sails, pump attended to

Saturday February 2 First part of these day fresh breezes from the trade and clear weather vessel under main try sail fore sail and fit on Starboard tack at 8: A.M. we were rounded on Port tack, saw a three mast schooner bound to Southwest at 6: P.M. we took in fore sail set for try sail pump attended to - No observation

Sunday February 3 First part of these day strong breezes from the trade and foggy weather vessel under main try sail fore sails and fit standing to the windward on Starboard tack "Manta" in sight at 6: P.M. we took in fore sails set fore try sail - pump attended to  
Lat 18°30 Long 24°30

Monday February 4 First part of these day light breezes from the trade and clear weather, at day light we made all sail on Port tack, crew making Sennet "John Manta" in sight at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to  
Lat 18°06 Long 24°19

Tuesday Feb. 5 First part of these day light breezes from the trade and clear weather, in morning we made all sail on Port tack standing to the windward at noon we ship on Starboard tack, crew making Sennet, "Manta" in sight in morning at sun set shorting sails
