Wednesday April 24 First part of this day very strong wind from the South West with squally and heavy rain we took in main sail and fore sails and we set fore and main try sails, latter part wind she let to the N West and moderate breeze we set fore sails and fly in fit Saw a Steamer bound to the West pump attended to

Friday April 26 First part of this light South East Wind and clear weather Vessel under all sails set Steer N E crew making sunset Saw a two mast Schooner bound to the North East pump attended to

Saturday April 27 First part of this day light South Wind, and clear weather, Vessel under all sails set running off and steer N E, latter part fresh breeze with cloudy weather, at 5:30 P.M. we raised large alone Whale going to the Windward we lower two Boats but we can't get near at dark the boats come on board we hoist up and we took in main sail and set main try sail pump attended to, no observation this day sun obscured

Sunday April 28 First part of this day fresh breeze from the Northeast, and rough sea in morning we cross the Gulf Stream, Vessel under fore sail main try sail and head sails standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, Saw lots of porpoises Saw a number of Steamers and the mast Schooner bound to South West at sun set shorting sails pump attended to

Monday April 29 First part of this day fresh breeze from the Northeast with foggy weather Vessel under shorting sails standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, pump attended to
