Wednesday May 8 First part of this day very light breezes from the North East and fog. Vessel under all sails set cruising, at noon we saw a Whaling Schooner to the Windward with Boats down Chasing Whales we did not lower the Boats we was too far to the leeward, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 37.54 Long 71.40 W

Thursday May 9 First part of this day fresh breezes from the South West and rough sea on with, heavy thick fog all day, Vessel under shorting sails laying to on Port tack. Crew wash the Vessel in sight at 4.5 PM the wind shifted to the North West we were round on Starboard tack, great swell from the Northeast - pump attended to

Friday May 10 First of this day very light breezes from the South West and thick fog - latter part weather clear up we made the sails standing to the South on Starboard tack, at 1. PM we raised a school of Small Whales, going to the South West we lower 3 Boats, and we catch two S.B. 1 - S.B. 1 We take this Whales along side at 3.30 PM. and we put gear up all ready to cut in next morning - and we shorting sails and set Watch pump - attended to
Lat 38.04 Long 70.5

Saturday May 11 First part of this day strong breezes from the South West and cloudy with rain in morning at 6: AM we start out in Whales, at 11. AM we finished cut in Whales, and we took the gear on and clear up the heads and wire ship on Port tack latter part heavy blowing with rain squall and the wind shifted to the North West pump attended to
No observation seen obscure

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Sunday May 12 First part of this day strong breezes from the North West and clear weather Vessel under shorting sails, standing to the Windward & on Starboard tack at 8 AM moderate Wind we start the fire, at 2.30 PM we raised a school of Small Whales we lower 2 Boats & B. catch one Small Whale, and S.B. streak but the line part - he lugs his Whales we take this Whale along side at 5: PM and we standing to the North with all sails set to get out of Stream at 8 PM we shorting sails lay on Starboard tack pump attended to
Lat 38.06 Long 70.29

Monday May 13 First part of this day light breezes from the West and clear weather, at daylight we commence to cut in Whales at 8 AM finished cut in and we raised a school of Small Whales we lower 3 Boats and we catch 3, S.B. 1 - S.B. 1 - W.B. 1 We take this Whales along side at 10 AM. at 2 clock we start cut in, at 5 PM we finished cut in and two more left to cut next day and we clear up the head, at 1 PM we set Watch pump, attended to
Lat 38.16 N - Long 69.54 W

Tuesday May 14 First part of this day dead calm at daylight we commence to cut in Whales at 6 clock we raised a school of Small Whales and we lower one boat S.B. catch 1 whale we take this whale along side at 10 AM. at 1 PM we finished cut in and we take gear down and we clear up the head, and we put some oil down, at 4 PM we raised another school of Small Whales, we did not lower the Boats because we block up on deck, pump attended to at 3 PM we start the fire
