Wednesday May 15 First part of this day very light breeze from the East and foggy weather. Vessel under shorting sails boiling on port tack - at 8^h AM we were ship on Starboard tack at noon we raised a school of small Whales we lower 3 Boats we catch 2 S.B. & 1 W.B. & 1 Boat struck on the Iron drove off. We take this Whales along side at 4^h PM and we keep the fire going and we stow some oil down, pumps attended to.

Lat 38.24 Long 69.39

Thursday May 16 First part of this day very light breezes from the South West and clear weather in morning we set main sail and we commence to cut in Whales, at 11. Clock AM we finished cut in, and we took gears down and we clear up the head, and we keep fire going, we raised a school of small Whales, but we did not lower the Boats because we block up on deck at 4^h PM we took main sail and were round on Port tack. We stow some oil down. pumps attended to.

Friday May 17 First part of this day calm with rain vessel under shorting sails boiling at 6^h AM we raised a school of small whales going to the windward we did not lower the Boats this day we stow some oil down pumps attended to.

Lat 39.00 Long 69.39

Saturday May 18 First part of this day strong breezes from the Southeast and rough sea with rain vessel under shorting sails, boiling this day we put some oil down latter part the weather clear up and rain stops we set gear and run to the South saw a school of Black fish pumps attended to.

Lat 39.00 Long 69.53

Saw two small Salmon bound to South

Sunday May 19 First part of this day fresh breezes from the South West with foggy weather under two try sails and full bellied at 4.30 PM we finished boiling and we put some oil down and we wash the vessel in sight pumps attended to.

Lat 38.37 Long 69.41

Monday May 20 First part of this day strong breezes from the South West and foggy with rain vessel under shorting sails this day we finished stow down the oil and wash the vessel in side at 4^h PM we raised a school of small Whales we lower two Boats the S.B. struck a young Bull we take this Whales along side at 5.30 PM and we haul the boats up and we got supper and set watch - pumps attended to.

Lat 39.00 Long 70.05

Tuesday May 21 First part of this day blowing strong from the N West with rough sea on in morning we commence to cut in Whales but we can not cut in in account of heavy sea running we remain till next day vessel under shorting sails laying to on Starboard tack pumps attended to.

Lat 38.49 Long 70.24

Wednesday May 22 First part of this day strong breezes from the North West with rough sea on at day light we commence to cut in Whales at 8^h AM we finished and we took gears down and we clear up the head at noon we raised a school of small Whales we lower two Boats the Whales going quick to the windward the Boats can't get near Whales went out of sight Boats come to Board we haul up and we start fire at 5^h PM we raised another school of small Whales we lower to Boats but we can't catch the Whales they went to the West.

Lat 38.20 Long 70.24

Saw 3 small Salmon off duty black
