We lower the boats, but the Whales going quick to the Westward then went out of sight the Boat returned on board we hoist the and we standing to the West on Port tack at sun set we starting sails pump attended to.

Tuesday June, 25 - First part of this day light wind from the South West and cloudy with rain vessel under two try sails and jib, standing to the windward on Starboard tack. This day we brought hard Bread and start new cask Beef and other small store pump attended to.

Wednesday June 26 First part of this day strong breeze from the South West with rough sea on vessel under two try sails and jib standing to the windward on Port tack crew making snitch pump attended to.

Lat 38.14 Long 71.04

Thursday June, 27 First part of this day fresh breeze from the West with rain and rough sea later part moderate wind we made sails standing to the Northward. Saw a lot of porpoises, pump attended to.

Lat 38.16 Long 71.00

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Friday June, 28 First part of this day very strong wind from the South West and clear weather vessel under two try sails and jib on Port tack later part heavy rain squall we took in jib pump attended to.

Lat 38.22 Long 71.07

Saturday June, 29 First part of this day very light breeze from the South West and cloudy weather vessel under fore sails main try sails and head sails standing to the windward on Starboard tack later part very strong breeze with rough sea on and heavy squall we took in fore sails and head sails pump attended to.

Lat 38.34 Long 71.54

Sunday June, 30 First part of this day very strong breeze from the South West and rough sea on - at noon moderate wind we set fore sails and flying jib on Starboard tack at 1 clock. We raised a lone Whale going quick to the South East; we did not lower the boats the Whales went out sight at sun set we took in fore sails pump attended to.

Lat 38.38 Long 71.36

Monday July 1 First part of this day very light wind from the South West and foggy vessel under all sails jib standing to the windward at sun set we starting sails pump attended to.

Lat 38.18 Long 71.43

Tuesday July 2 First of this day strong West breeze with rain vessel under starting sails standing to the South on Starboard tack. Saw a steamer bound to the North East. We brought Ream pump attended to.
