Tuesday July 30 First part of this day light South West wind at day light we commenced cut in whale at 5 clock we finished cut in and we took gears down and took in main sails set main try sails and we start fire and we set watch at 4 clock P.M. the "Pedro Paula" in sight Broast Park, pump attended to.
Lat 32.20 Long 46.29

Wednesday July 31 First part of this day light South wind and clear weather Vessel under shorting sails, boiling on on Port tack. "Pedro Paula" in sight boiling this day we stow some oils down, pump attended to.
Lat 32.11 N Long 46.15

Thursday August 1 First part of this day gentle breezes from the South West and cloudy weather Vessel under the sails and head sails boiling, we put some oil down at 10 clock P.M. we finished boiling - pump attended to.
Lat 32.10 Long 46.09

Friday August 2 First part of this day very light wind from the South West and clear weather Vessel under all sails set cruising this day we finished stow down the oils and wash the Vessel in side pump attended to.
We start new Cask of B.P. Lat 32.15 Long 46.31

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Saturday August 3 First part of this day dead calm all day Vessel under shorting sails came making Dagon at 7.35 P.M. we raised a large alone Whale, gain East, we lower two Boats the L Boat got fast and S Boat all got fast the Whale sound down hard take all the line from both Boats we lower & lob of lines the Whale went out of sight at 8.20 P.M. we take the Boats up pump attended to.

Sunday August 4 First part of this day dead calm all day Vessel under no sails set at 1 clock in morning we raised a large Whale we lower three Boats the L Boat struck him we take this Whale along side at 6 clock P.M. and we got gears up all ready to cut in next morning we got supper and we set watch pump attended to.
Lat 32.48 Long 46.01

Monday August 5 First part of this day light breezes from the East and clear weather at day light we commenced cut in whale at 7.30 P.M. we finished cut in and took gears down and bell at the case and we start the fire pump attended to.
Lat 32.57 Long 46.26

Tuesday August 6 First part of this day very light breezes from the East and clear weather Vessel under shorting sails, boiling on Port tack this day we stow some oils down we Broast milk, kept repair the S Boat at 6 P.M. we ship in Starboard tank pump attended to.
Lat 32.10 Long 46.39

Pedro Paula in sight at 4.30 P.M. this day we set the coils of new line take 10 coils
