Thursday August 8 First part of this day dead calm all day, vessel under two trysails and fit we finished, sailing this day we finished stow down the oil we stow down 65 barrels and we wash the vessel in side, four merchant vessel in sight bound to the Eastward pump attended to
Lat 34.00 Long 46.53

Friday August 9 First part of this day light East wind with smooth sea on and clear weather, at day light we made all sails on Port tack, standing to the Eastward saw merchant vessel bound to the East and Grampas at sun set we shorting sails, pump attended to
Lat 34.00 Long 46.53

Saturday August 10 First part of this day fresh breeze from the South West and clear weather, vessel under all sails set running off and steer ESE saw a Grampas at sun set we shorting sails Brockowl hard bread, pump attended to
Lat 34.04 Long 46.32

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Sunday August 11 First part of this day strong South West wind with rough sea, vessel under fore sails, main trysails and fit running off, steer ESE at sun set we took in fore sails and fit, we set bare trysails and lug, to on Starboard tack pump attended to
Lat 34.10 Long 44.37

Monday August 12 First part of this day very light wind from the West and clear weather vessel under all sails set running off to the Eastward, saw a Grampas at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 34.10 Long 43.27

Tuesday August 13 First part of this day dead calm later part, very light wind from the South West this day we catch some fish crew making back on at sun set we taking fore sails and set fore trysails pump attended to
Lat 34.19 Long 42.23

Wednesday August 14 First part of this day light wind from the North West and clear weather in morning we made all sails, and running off ESE this day we set up the fore and main reefs saw a Grampas at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 34.35 Long 41.45

Thursday August 15 First part of this day very light wind from the West and clear weather vessel under all sails set running off ESE saw a merchant vessel bound to the Eastward at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 34.37 Long 41.11-W
