Saturday August 24 First part of this day strong breeze from the South East with squally Ciel under shorting sails standing to the windward on Starboard tack at 6:30 P.M. we wore ship on Port tack and the weather clear up pump attended to

Sunday August 25 First part of this day very strong wind from the South East with squally and rain Ciel under two try sails and fore stay sails standing on windward on Port tack later fell moderate wind and the rain stop we wore round on Starboard tack pump attended to -

No observation sun obscure

Monday August 26 First part of this day gentle breeze from the South West and clear weather Ciel under main try sails fore sails and head sails running off ESE at 9:15 A.M. we raised a two Bull whales we lower three boats we saw them all day but we can't not get one, them at dark the boats returned on board we shorting sails lay on Port tack pump attended to

Tuesday August 27 First part of this day gentle breeze from the South West and cloudy weather Ciel under main try sails fore sail and head sails running off ESE at 2:15 P.M. we raised a school of young Bull we lower three boats we got 3 whales S B-2 S B-4 we take this whale along side at dark we shorting sails pump attended to

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Wednesday August 28 First part of this day very light wind from the North West with the clear weather at day light we set main sail on Starboard tack and we comence to cut in Whales at 6:30 P.M. we finished cut in whale we took in main sails and we got gear down and we clear up one head and let the wash gear below pump attended to

Thursday August 29 First part of this day very light breeze from the West and clear weather Ciel under main try sails and head sails boiling on Port tack we knock out hard bread pump attended to

Lat 37.25 N Long 34.34 W

Friday August 30 First part of this day dead calm Ciel under no sails set-boiling this day we pump out some fresh water and put some down gear cask pump attended to

Lat 37.10 N Long 34.35 W

Saturday August 31 First part of this day very light wind from the South East and clear weather Ciel under main try sails and head sails standing on wind on Starboard tack still boiling we put some oil down and pump out some fresh water have cask ready for oil pump attended to

Lat 37.05 N Long 34.33 W

Sunday September 1 First part of this day fresh breeze from the South East Ciel under all sails set working to the windward on Starboard tack this day we finished stow down oil gear whale the wash in back pump attended to

Lat 37.13 N Long 34.40 W
