Monday Sept. 2 First part of this day gentle breeze from the South East and clear weather. Vessel under all sails set heading S.E., saw a lot of pumps and porpoises pump attended to
Satt 31.45.10.33.41

Tuesday Sept 3 First part of this day fresh breeze from the South with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading S.E. at 4. P.M. we sighted the Islands of Fayal and Pico about forty miles off. We rated our chronometer. We 100 miles out to the West saw a lot of porpoises pump attended to.

Wednesday September 4 First of this day fresh breeze from the South East with clear weather. The Pico in sight in morning. Vessel under all sails set crew wash the vessel in sight at 4. P.M. we sighted the St. Michael at 6.30 P.M. shorting sails lay near the land and we land the cable pump attended to
No observation this day

Thursday September 5 First part of this day fresh breeze from the South East with rain. Vessel under all sails set letting up at 5.30 P.M. we got in the Ponta Delgada harbor, the Pilot come on board to morning the vessel. We found more the Whales in at 7 clock start heavy rain we can not finished morning the vessel saw hand of this day
No observation

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Friday Sept. 6 at St. Michael with rain we finished morning the vessel and we washed the vessel out side in evening one watch went shore. the Capt send some fresh meat and potatoes and fructos on board. Saw hand of this day

Saturday 7 at St. Michael with rain all day. We can't not start any work in account of rain, in evening the last watch went shore and returned board at 9 clock P.M.

sept
Sunday 8 at St. Michael harbor with fine weather, one watch went shore in morning and returned board at noon and the other watch went, returned board at 2 clock P.M. Saw hand of this day

sept-9
Monday at St. Michael with clear weather we start to set up the cask, at noon began to rain we stop, we take on two bags of Potatoes & onion

Tuesday Sept 10 at St. Michael with light wind and clear weather we commence to set up the cask we take on Copper from shore help on board

Wednesday Sept 11 at St. Michael with heavy rain at noon clear weather we commence to discharge some oils to "Fredrick Ruessner" - saw hand of this day

Thursday Sept 12 at St. Michael with fine weather we set up the cask and discharge oils on lights to "F. Ruessner"
