Wednesday October 30 First part of this day strong breeze from the S.E. with clear weather. Vessel under main sails fore sails and head sails on Port tack heading S.E. W. crew making Sente pump attended to

Thursday October 31 First part of this day fresh breeze from the S.E. with clear weather. Vessel under main sails fore sails and head sails heading S.W. by S on Port tack. This day we lost one barrel of melon, the head burst off and melon run all out in hole. At 7 P.M. the weather got squally with strong wind we took in main sails and set main try sails pump attended to

Lat 4° 12' S Long 28° 34' W

Friday November 1 First part of this day strong breeze from the South East with squally weather. Vessel under main try sails fore sails and head sails standing on Wind on Port tack pump attended to

Lat 5° 50' S Long 27° 04' W

Saturday November 2 First part of this day strong breeze with clear weather. Vessel under reefed main sails and fore sail and head sails heading S.E. West on Port tack at 6 P.M. we chased reef out main sails crew making Sente pump attended to

Lat 7° 12' S Long 27° 46' W

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Sunday November 3 First part of this day moderate wind we set gay tops on Port tack. Vessel heading South by West crew making Sente pump attended to

Lat 8° 58' S Long 28° 19' W

Monday November 4 First part of this day very light breeze from East with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading S.E. East this day we set up the main square and fore and back up the fore top (mast the cross tree broke off) pump attended to

Lat 10° 32' S Long 28° 09' W

Tuesday November 5 First part of this day strong breeze from the Southeast with rough sea. Vessel under main try sail fore sail and head sails heading S.E. on Port tack we unlaid the flying jib to repair, pump attended to

Lat 12° 38' S Long 28° 29' W

Wednesday November 6 First part of this day strong breeze from the South East with cloudy weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading S.E. at 8 P.M. weather got squally we took in main sails set main try sails, pump attended to

Lat 14° 26' S Long 26° 41' W

Thursday November 7 First part of this day strong breeze from the South East with cloudy weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading S.E. crew making Sente at 6 P.M. we took in main sails set main try sails pump attended to
