Lat 19.10 S Long 23.00 W

Sunday November 10 First part of this day light breeze from the West with cloudy weather. Vessel under all sails set running off S.E. & pump attended to.

Lat 19.55 S Long 21.36 W

Monday November 11 First part of this day light wind from the West with rain and cloudy weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack running off and steering S.E. & pump attended to. No observation this day.

Tuesday November 12 First part of this day very light wind from the North West with rain. Vessel under all sails set running off stern S.E. East crew making Senete pump attended to.

Wednesday Nov. 13 First part of this day calm and light wind from the N.W. with little rain on vessel under all sails set steering S.E. & crew making Senete pump attended to.

Lat 24.55 S Long 16.27 W

Saturday November 16 First part of this day fresh breeze with squalls. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack, stern S.E. & crew employed on repair the head gear pump attended to.

Lat 26.30 S Long 14.57 W

Sunday November 17 First part of this day very light wind from the trade and clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack crew making Senete, saw a Fin back pump attended to.

Lat 27.07 S Long 13.09 W

Monday November 18 First part of this day very light wind from the S.W. with cloudy weather and rain. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack standing on Windward at 8.2. No dead calm we took in sea pump attended to.

Lat 27.50 S Long 11.36 W

Tuesday November 19 First part of this day dead calm all day Vessel under no sails set, crew employed on repair the main sails and fore sails, at 4.16 we raised a school of Small Whales soon quick to East we lower the Boats but we can't get them, the Boats returned on Board 28/25 Long 11.43
