Thursday November 21 First part of this day light breeze from the North West with rainy weather hove under all sails running off and steer off South, saw a Fin back at 6: P.M. dead calm we took in all the sails pump attended to
 Lat 29° 39' S Long 10° 31' W

Friday November 22 First part of this day very light from the West with heavy swell from the Southwest hove under all sails set on Starboard tack steering off South saw a Gramp crew making sent, pump attended to
 Lat 29° 54' S Long 10° 13' W

Saturday November 23 First part of this day dead calm, with swell from the N East hove under no sail set crew making sent pump attended to
 Lat 30° 47' S Long 10° 10' W

Sunday November 24 First part of this day very light wind from the North East, with clear weather, hove under all sails set steer off South on Port tack saw a school of Gramp crew making sent pump attended to
 Lat 31° 11' S Long 10° 10' W

Monday November 25 First part of this day light breeze from the N East with very clear weather hove under all sails set on Port tack steer off S & E saw lots of Fin backs crew making sent, pump attended to
 Lat 32° 06' S Long 8° 57' W

Tuesday November 26 First part of this day light West wind the south sea on hove under all sails set on Port tack running off steer S & E saw a Kamp back gain to the windward and lots of Fin backs at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
 Lat 32° 13' S Long 8° 05' W

Wednesday November 27 First part of this day very light wind from the West with clear weather hove under all sails set on Port tack running off and steer S & E saw a Fin back crew making sent at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
 Lat 32° 06' S Long 7° 04' W

Thursday November 28 First part of this day very light wind with calm, hove under all sails set on Port tack running off E & E crew making sent saw a lot of Porpoises and Fin back at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
 Lat 31° 56' S Long 6° 11' W

Friday November 29 First part of this day fresh breeze from the North West with cloudy weather hove under main try sails fore sail and head sails running off steer South on Starboard tack saw a Fin back at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
