Saturday November 30 First part of this day strong West Wind with rough sea on vessel under shorting sails running off on Port tack stern ESE saw a pin back at 6:10 we lay to on Starboard tack pump attended to
Lat 32° 12' S Long 0° 13' E

Sunday December 1 First part of this day very light wind from the West with smooth sea on vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading SEast saw a pin back at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 31° 50' S Long 2° 38' W

Monday December 2 First part of this day light breeze from the NEast with clear weather vessel under all sails set heading SE by E saw a lot of pin backs crew making shon at sun set we took in main sails, set main trysails pump attended to
Lat 32° 09' S Long 2° 05' W

Tuesday December 3 First part of this day light wind from the NEast with clear weather vessel under all sails set run off stern ESE saw a pin back, Manuel Lombard off duty sick with fever, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 32° 02' S Long 2° 03' W

Wednesday December 4 First part of this day very light wind from the NEast with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading SE by E at noon saw a hump back whale and 3 or 4 other whales but we can't get near the boat returned on board at 4:26
Lat 34° 43' S Long 4° 26' W

Manuel Lombard off duty sick with fever
Prochard, Glau and Enger return to the vessel
Manuel Lombard returned to his duty

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Thursday December 5 First part of this day very strong wind from the South East with rough sea on vessel under main trysail fore sails and jib running off stern ESE on Starboard tack vessel shipped some water on deck, pump attended to
Lat 29° 13' S Long 0° 13' E

Friday December 6 First part of this day very strong wind from the SEast with cloudy weather and rough sea on vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack stern E by N vessel shipped much water on deck, pump attended to
Lat 27° 00' S Long 1° 39' E

Saturday December 7 First part of this day strong breeze from the SE with rough sea on vessel under main trysail fore and head sails stuyaring E by N on Starboard tack vessel shipped some water on deck, pump attended to
Lat 25° 26' S Long 2° 51' E

Sunday December 8 First part of this day strong breeze from the SEast with rough sea on vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack pump attended to
Lat 24° 12' S Long 4° 10' E

Monday December 9 First part of this day light wind from the SE with clear weather at day light we set all the sails on Starboard tack heading E by N crew making sent pump attended to
Lat 23° 26' S Long 4° 54' E

Tuesday December 10 First part of this day dead calm vessel under no sails set we unbend the fore sails to repair, at 4:10 we bend the fore sails, pump attended to
Lat 22° 20' S Long 5° 35' E
