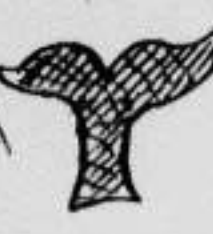
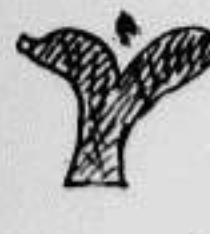

Saw a school of Black fish we lower 3 boats, but we can't get any of them, the boats returned on board, at sun set we took in main sails set main trysails pump attended to.

Monday December 30 First part of this day fresh breeze from the SE with cloudy weather -  Under all sails on Port tack standing on windward. Saw a school of Black fish and porpoise at 6: P.M. we raised a school of small whales, but we did not lower the boats, was to later, we shorting sails pump attended to.

Tuesday December 31 First part of this day fresh breeze from the SE with cloudy weather. Under all sails set on Starboard tack, crew making sent saw a Black fish and porpoise at 6: P.M. we took in main sails and flying jib lay on Port tack pump attended to. No observation sun obscure.

Wednesday January 1 1908
Happy new year to all on board.
 First part of this day light breeze from the SE with cloudy weather. Under all sails set on Starboard tack standing on windward at 10: A.M. we raised a school of small whales, going quick to the windward, we lower 3 boats and chase them all fore noon at 4: P.M. the boats returned on board can't not catch them. The Whales went out of sight at 6: P.M. we shorting sails pump attended to. No observation sun obscure.

Thursday January 2 First part of this day light breeze from the SE with foggy weather. Under all sails set on Starboard tack working to the windward saw a lot of porpoises and Fin back, at sun set we took in main sails set main trysails pump attended to.

Lat 8° 10' S Long 101° 18' E

Friday January 3 First part of this day calm with very light wind from the SE and cloudy weather. Under all sails set on Port tack working to the windward saw a Fin back, at sun set shorting sails pump attended to.

Lat 8° 19' S Long 111° 14' E

Saturday January 4 First part of this day fresh breeze from the SE with clear weather. Under all sails set on Starboard tack working to the windward, saw a Fin back crew making ration pump attended to.

Lat 8° 32' S Long 111° 36' E

Sunday January 5 First part of this day very light wind from the SE with cloudy weather. Under all sails set on Starboard tack working to the windward, saw a lot of porpoises. Crew making sent pump attended to.

Lat 9° 06' S Long 111° 39' E

Monday January 6 First part of this day light SE wind with smoky weather. Under all sails set on Port tack standing on windward crew making ration saw a porpoise and fin back pump attended to.

Lat 9° 45' S Long 111° 49' E
