Friday January 17 First part of this day fresh breeze from the S.W. with foggy weather. Under all sails set on Port tack, heaving to the windward. Crew making bakum at sun set we shorting sails. Lat 15.11 Long 12.12

Saturday January 18 First part of this day fresh breeze from the S.W. with clear weather. At day light we made all sails on Starboard tack, saw a lot of porpoises at sun set we shorting sails. Pump attended to. Lat 15.28 Long 12.01

Sunday January 19 First part of this day light breeze from the S.W. with clear weather. At day light we made all sails on Starboard tack. At noon wore ship on Port tack. At sun set we shorting sails. Pump attended to. Lat 15.40 Long 12.50

Monday January 20 First part of this day dead calm, crew under two try sails and fore stay sails. At 7:30 A.M. we paid to school of small whales, we lower 3 boats and we catch 4 whales. 3 B-1 = WB-2 = SB-1 = 70 lbs. but we take this whales along side at dark, and we shorting sails. This day we lost the stern boat, the main boom top left part the boom struck on boat, the stern dave got out, the boat going, pump attended to. No observation this day.

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Tuesday January 21 First part of this day very light wind from the S.W. with clear weather. At day light we commence to eat in whales. At dark we cut 3 small whales, and we cut head off a large whale, and we lost the case the main part, pump attended to. Lat 15.23 Long 12.00

Wednesday January 22 First part of this day light breeze from the S.W. with cloudy weather. At day light we commence to cut in large whales. At 8:45 we finished cut in at 10: A.M. we start the fire land in sight at 6: P.M. we took in main sails, set main try sails. Pump attended to. No observation this day.

Thursday January 23 First part of this day light breeze from the S.W. with cloudy weather. Crew under main try sails and head sails boiling. This day we put some oil down at 7: P.M. we wore round on Port tack. Pump attended to. No observation sun plague.

Friday January 24 First part of this day light breeze from the S.W. with clear weather. Crew under main try sails and head sails on Starboard tack boiling. At 10: P.M. we finished boiling. Pump attended to. Lat Long

Saturday January 25 First part of this day fresh breeze from the S.W. with clear weather. In morning we set main sails on Starboard tack standing to the windward. This day we stow the oil down, and stow off the hole at sun set we shorting sails. Land in sight. Pump attended to. No observation this day.
