Tuesday January 28 First part of this day fresh breeze from the West with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack at noon wore ship on Starboard tack at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Sunday February 2 First part of this day moderate breeze from the West with clear weather at day light we made all sail on Starboard tack saw a porpoise at sun set we wore ship on Port tack and we shorting sails pump attended to.
Lat 15° 52' S Long 11° 18' E

Monday February 3 First part of this day light breeze from the West with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack standing on windward at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.
Lat 16° 25' S Long 11° 30' E

Tuesday February 4 First part of this day dead calm at 10 A.M. spring up little breeze we made all sails on Starboard tack store West saw a porpoise crew making smoke at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.
