Saturday February 29 First part of this day fresh breeze from the East with rough sea on vessel under main trysails fore sails and head sails running off starboard, crew making sente pump, attended to.

Lat 15° 00' S Long 8° 28' E

Sunday March 1 First part of this day strong breeze from the SE with great swell from the South vessel under shorting sails running off NW, saw a porpoise pump, attended to.

Lat 14° 44' S Long 6° 10' E

Monday March 2 First part of this day light breeze from the East with heavy swell from the South, vessel under shorting sails running off NW, crew making sente pump, attended to.

Lat 14° 50' S Long 4° 28' E

Tuesday March 3 First part of this day light breeze with heavy swell from the West vessel under fore sails main trysails and head sails running off, and stern NW, we repaired the Main sails at 4 P.M. we finished and we set main sails on Port tack pump, attended to.
