

at Dominica 1907

Monday April 6 First part of this fresh breezes with rain all day. This day we commence to pump out salt water, got ready to fill them with fresh water and we can some empty cask shore and take board some fresh meat.

Tuesday April 7 At Dominica with strong breeze from the trade, and rain & squally. This day we creek the mast and fill the cask on shore we took board one bag sugar 200 lb. saw head of the day.

Wednesday April 8 At Dominica with strong breeze and heavy rain, at noon moderate wind and rain we spade barrel Pork, and we finish scrub the mast, at 6 P.M. one watch went shore.

Thursday April 9 at Dominica with fresh breeze and rain we took some water on board. and sent the vessel out side we take 5 barrels sweet potatoes, saw head of this day at 6 P.M. one watch went shore.

Friday April 10 at Dominica with light wind and clear weather this day we hold the vessel along side of ship to discharge the oils, we shipped 4 cask saw head of this day.

Saturday April 11 at Dominica with fresh breeze we still lay along side of ship to discharge oils. we finished discharging the oils and we take some provision saw head of this day.

Sunday April 12 at Dominica with fine weather in morning one watch went shore returned at noon and the other went returned board at night.

Monday April 13 at Dominica with fine weather we took all the provision from Schooner - except 5 cask sarsaparilla, oil don't find in board schooner, at 3 P.M. we get off from schooner we anchor in 6 fathom water. We took some water on board.

Tuesday April 14 at Dominica with strong breeze and rain all day we can't make no work. This day.

Wednesday April 15 at Dominica with moderate wind and rain we commence to take fresh water on board saw head of this day.

Thursday April 16 at Dominica with light wind and rain we still took water water and wood, we sell 2 barrels flour saw head of this day.

Friday April 17 at Dominica with light wind we took fresh water on board and wood and take 4 dozen Iron poles.

Saturday April 18 at Dominica with fresh wind and squally all day we still making water, and take wood on board. We take 5 barrels sweet potatoes, and 1 cask Mellace 184 gal.

Sunday April 19 at Dominica with strong wind and clear weather, we taking fresh water on board, and we finished take wood we take 5 cask saw head of this day.

Monday April 20 at Dominica with light wind and rain we finished taking water and we sent some shoes shore, to Remondie till new year and some empty casks - Total amount (18 Empty cask) Shoes 8 Cask.
