

Tuesday April 21 at Dominica with fine weather, this day we finished painting the vessel out side and we trade James for Pork, we took 2 bags Sugar and 3 Cases sarsaparilla one bag rice, 2 crates, some southernd of this day

Wednesday April 22 at Dominica with fresh breezes from the back and heavy rain squally in afternoon weather clear up we fix the head gear and get vessel ready to sea --

Thursday April 23 at Dominica with fresh wind and clear weather at 10 P.M. we clear from Customhouse, at 1 P.M. we sail from Dominica for St. Eustatius vessel with all sails set on Starboard tack steer NW by N. We take one Boy from Bark, Steam Boat name John Sykes for Cabin boy.

Friday April 24 at Dominica at 10 we come to anchor at St. Eustatius in 6 fathoms water, we find the Bark "Bertha" and Dutch Schooner "Amy Johnson", we wash the vessel in side ready to paint

Saturday April 25 at St. Eustatius with fresh breezes we commence to paint the vessel in side

Sunday April 26 St. Eustatius with fresh wind some of the crew went shore and returned board at noon

Monday April 27 at St. Eustatius with light wind we finished painting the vessel inside and we set up the top rigging

Tuesday April 28 at St. Eustatius with light wind we took 6 Barrels Lima and some Pompadour southernd of this day

Wednesday April 29 at St. Eustatius with light wind we paint all the Boats, and we take 15 barrels Sweet potatoes and 3 sarsaparilla for crew and get vessel ready to sea at 2.30 P.M. we sail from St. Eustatius for cruise in company with Bark Bertha pump attended to.

Thursday April 30 First part of this day light breezes from the SE with clear weather vessel under all sails set running off shore N by W. pump attended to

Friday May 1 First part of this day light breeze from the SE with clear weather Schooner under all sails set running off shore N by W - crew sweeping the iron works - and paint them pump attended to
Latt Long

Saturday May 2 First part of this day gentle breezes from the SE with clear weather vessel under all sails set running off shore N by W - saw a Steamer bound to West pump attended to
Latt Long

Sunday May 3 First part of this day light breeze from the SE with very clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack. Steer N by W - saw a Steamer bound to SE East crew making senets pump attended to
