Tuesday July 21 First part of this day light breezes from the West with clear weather. Dred under all sails set on Starboard tack heading South. Saw a Finback, and Steamer bound to South West Cove making points - at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Wednesday July 22 First of this day very light breezes from the West with foggy weather. Dred under all sails set on Starboard tack, working to the Windward. We pass a four mast Schooner, name "Gen. E. S. Greeley" bound to Westward on Port tack, at sun set we shorting sails Pump attended to

Thursday July 23 First of this day dead calm. In morning we send down the fore top mast, at noon spring up breezes from West we made all sails on Starboard tack, at 4: P.M. we raised a school of small whales, we lower B Boats, chase them till dark can't get near the boats returned on board we hoist up and shorting sails Pump attended to

Friday July 24 First part of this day very light breezes from the S.W. at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack, at 5: A.M. we raised a school of small whales, we lower three boats, we catch 2 small whales B=1- SB=1- we take this whale along side at 2:30 P.M. we put gear up and we cut it finished at 6:20 P.M. and detail fire

Saturday July 25 First part of this day dead calm all day, Dred under no sails set, bailing we pump out some fresh water to have back ready for oils, pumps attended to

Lat 37.52 Long 73.34

Sunday July 26 First part of this day dead calm all day Dred under no sails set at 1: A.M. we finished bailing and we put some oil down. Steamer bound to NE - pump attended to

Lat 37.50 Long 73.39

Monday July 27 First part of this day dead - calm, Dred under no sails set we finished stow down the oil and stow off the hold and wash the Dred in sight. Saw a lot of porpoises, pumps attended to

Lat 37.46 Long 73.34

Tuesday July 28 First part of this day very light breezes from the NE with clear weather at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack, at 10: A.M. we raised a school of small whales, we lower three boats, we catch 3 small whales B=2 SB=1- we take this whale along side at 3: P.M. we put gear up and we commence cut in at 6:20 P.M. we finished cut in and we took gear down and we clear up the head we shorting sails pump attended to
