Sunday May 23rd First part of this day light breeze from West with thick fog. Vessel under shorting sails, running off shore. At 10 AM saw a school of Black Fish and Steamer bound to Eastward at noon weather clear up we made all sail, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Monday May 24th First part of this day light breeze from the West with foggy weather. Vessel under full sails set running off shore a Grampus - and Pinback. Crew make senet, at sun set we shorting sails, pump attended to.

Tuesday May 25th First part of this day fresh breeze from the West with clear weather. Vessel under full sails main topsails and full on Port tack at 9:30 AM. We raised a school of small whales we lower three Boats we catch 2 small Whales - S.B. - We take this along side at 2:30 P.M. and we put gear up we commence to cut in at 7: P.M. we finish cutting we took gear down and clear up the head, pump attended to.

Wednesday May 26th First part of this day light breeze from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under shorting sails boiling we spoke to "Comco" she had 50 barrels since left St. Lawrence. She took from us one Boat mast three, Flykes Chains, three Steering oars, send by Capt. Joseph Edwards, latter part rains with strong breeze.

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Thursday May 27th First part of this day strong breeze from the West with foggy weather at 7: AM we finished boiling and commence rain, and rain all day, we raised a school of small Whales, we lower two Boats, Whales going quick to the windward, the Boats returned on board we hoist up and we got supper, we lay in on Port tack under two topsails and fore stay sails, pump attended to.

No observation sun obscure

Friday May 28th First part of this day very light breeze from the West with foggy weather. Vessel under main topsails foresails and head sails on Starboard tack at 11:30 AM we raised a school of small Whales, we lower three Boats S.B. got a small whale, we take this whale along side at 4:30 P.M. and we put gear up and we commence to cut in at 7: P.M. we finish cutting we clear up the head, pump attended to.

Lat 38° 02' Long 71° 04'

Saturday May 29th First part of this day fresh breeze from the West with cloudy weather. Vessel under shorting sails at 6:30 AM we raised a school of small Whales going to West we lower three Boats. W.B. got a small whale we take this whale along side at 11: clock and we commence to cut in, and raised another school of small Whales. We lower two Boats we catch two S.B. = 1 = L.B. = 1 = We take this Whales along side at 4:30 P.M. and we put gear up, and we have supper, Saw a Whaling schooner to the leeward of us pump attended to.
