Tuesday June 8 First part of this day strong breeze from the NE with cloudy weather and rain vessel under two trysails and jib on Starboard tack saw a lot of porpoises pump attended to. No observation

Wednesday June 9 First part of this day dead calm with heavy swell from the West vessel under shorting sails later part heavy rain with cloudy weather pump attended to No observation sun obscure

Thursday June 10 First part of this day light wind from the East with rain all day vessel under two trysails and jib on Port tack saw a Grampus and porpoises cruise near the vessel inside pump attended to No observation sun obscure

Friday June 11 First part of this day very light wind with squally and heavy swell from the West at 10: AM we raised a school of small Whales we lower three boats we catch one SB- we take this whale along side at 3: PM and we put gear up we start cutting at 5: PM we finished cutting we took gear down and clear up the head pump attended to No observation sun obscure

Saturday June 12 First part of this day very light wind from the NE with rain all day vessel under two trysails and jib on Port tack at 6: PM the rain stop we start fire saw lots of porpoises pump attended to No observation sun obscure

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Sunday June 13 First part of this day fresh breezes from the West with squally weather and rain at 5: AM we finished loading and we set fore sails on Port tack steering SE by E pump attended to Lat 37° 50' Long 67° 10' W

Monday June 14 First part of this day very light wind from the Southwest with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack steering SE by E at sunset dead calm we took in main sails set main trysails pump attended to Lat 36° 29' Long 67° 37' W

Tuesday June 15 First part of this day calm with light breezes vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading SE saw a Grampus at sunset we shorting sails pump attended to Lat 35° 50' Long 69° 56' W

Wednesday June 16 First part of this day very light wind from the South with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack saw a porpoise and grampus pump attended to Lat 35° 53' Long 69° 00' W

Thursday June 17 First part of this day dead calm all day vessel under no sails set this day we scree the mast pump attended to Lat 35° 24' Long 67° 48' W
