Monday June 21 First part of this day very light breezes from the West with clear weather Vessel under shorting sails boiling "T. Towner" in sight at 10:30 P.M. we finished boiling and we square up to "T. Towner" she took from us 6 barrels oil and we stave oil down pump attended to

Tuesday June 22 First part of this day very light wind from the West with Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack store SE by S at 3:30 PM we sighted the "T. Towner" with Boats down, we lower three Boats, we chase along Whale, can't get near at sun set Boats returned on Board we hoist up and shorting sails, pump attended to

Wednesday June 23 First part of this day fresh breezes from the West with clear weather Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack store SE - "T. Towner" went out sighted saw a merchant Bark going to Eastward at sun set we shorting sails

Thursday June 24 First part of this day fresh breezes from the SE with clear weather at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack store SE by E cruise make Senete at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Friday June 25 First part of this day light breezes from the West with clear weather at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack store E SE cruise making senete saw a merchant Schooner bound to West at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
