Monday July 5 First part of this day fresh breezes from the SE with cloudy weather. Vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack boiling, we put some oil down pump attended to.

Lat 32° 38' Long 48° 04'

Tuesday July 6 First part of this day fresh breezes from the SE with cloudy weather at 7: A.M. we finished boiling and we put some oil down, at 4:30 we raised a lone whale, we lower two boats, the whale did not stay up longer, at sun set boats returned on board, pump attended to.

Lat 33° 00' Long 48° 34'

Wednesday July 7 First part of this day fresh breezes from the SE with clear weather at day-light we made sails and we raised a school of small whales, we lower three boats we catch 2 small whales SB=1 SB=1 we take this whales along side at 8: P.M. and we put gear up we commence to cut in at noon we finished cutting up put gears down and clear up the head and we start fire pump attended to.

Lat 33° 20' Long 48° 35'

Thursday July 8 First part of this day strong breezes from the SE with rough sea on vessel under shorting sails on Port tack boiling at 7: P.M. we finished boiling pump attended to.

Lat 33° 42' Long 48° 38' W

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Friday July 9 First part of this day fresh breezes from the SE with clear weather vessel under shorting on Port tack, we stow oil down and wash the vessel in sight pump attended to.

Lat 33° 42' Long 48° 38' W

Saturday July 10 First part of this day light breezes from the SE with clear weather at daylight we made all sails on Port tack heading SW. We set up the fore and main regens, at sun set we shorting sails - pump attended to.

Lat 32° 05' Long 49° 44'

Sunday July 11 First part of day very light wind from the SE with clear weather at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack heading E by N. at 7:30 we raised a three Bell whales, to the windward we set up all day at 4: P.M. we lower three boats, the whale fell the boats then went out sight the boats returned on board, we hoist up and shorting sails pump attended to.

Lat 33° 40' W Long 49° 21' W

Monday July 12 First part of this day light breezes from the SE with clear weather at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack at 1:30 P.M. we sighted a large dead whale we lower one boat, to try them it was rotten and we find two tubs of lines and boat returned on board, we hoist up - at 7: P.M. we shorting sails pump attended to.
