Wednesday July 14 First part of this day light breezes from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under shorting sails boiling on Starboard tack, at 4: P.M. weather got cloudy with squally we were round on Port tack. pump attended to
No observation sun obscure

Thursday July 15 First part of this day fresh breezes with squally at 5: A.M. we finished boiling at 6: A.M. we raised a school of Bull Whales we lower three Boats. we chase them all forenoon at 1:30 P.M. L.B. struck a 40 lb bull, we take this whale along side at 3:30 P.M. and we stow down the oils and we got supper, pump attended to



Friday July 16 First part of this day very light breezes from the SE with heavy swell from the W at daylight we set main sails and comence to cutting whale at noon we finished cutting and we clear up the head and we set fire. Saw a merchant vessel bound to West at sun set we took in main sails set main try sail pump attended to

Saturday July 17 First part of this day dead calm with clear weather. Vessel under two try sails, and jib-boiling this day we have some sack ready for oils pump attended to

Sunday July 18 First part of this day light breezes from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading SSE, this day we stow oils down and clear out the deck, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 34:20 W Long 49:15 W

Monday July 19 First part of this day light breezes from the SE with clear weather in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack heading SSE, at noon we raised a lone whale, we lower three Boats chase them all after noon at dark Boat returned on Board, can't get near of them we shorting sails pump attended to



Lat 34:18 Long 48:27

Tuesday July 20 First part of this day very light breezes from the SE with clear weather at day light we raised a school of Bull Whales, to the windward, we made all sails on Port tack bellying up all forenoon at noon we lower the Boats, at 3:00 P.M. L.B. struck young Bull, at 4:30 we take this Whales along side and we put gears up all ready to cutting next morning and we shorting sails pump attended to
