We lower three Boats SB - Went on the whale. He felt the Boat he start to quick we shasen all day he went out sight the Boats returned on board at 5:30 PM. we saw a three Bull Whales to the forward we did not lower the Boats to far, we shorting sails pump attended to.

Wednesday August 11 First part of this day light breezes from the SW with clear weather at day light we raised a two young bull whale. We lower three Boats, SB catch one of them we take this whale along side at noon and cuttin, got gears down shorting sails pump attended to.

Sunday August 15 First part of this day light breezes from the SW with clear weather at 7:30 AM we raise a school of small Whales. We lower the Boats SB catch a small whale. We take this whale along side at noon and we cuttin in and took gears down and we get ore pump attended to.

Lat 33° 14' Long 42° 02'

Monday August 16 First part of this day light breezes from the SW with clear weather at day light we raise a school of small whales. We lower three Boats, whale was going quick to the Windward, the Boats returned on board we hoist up at 7:4 AM we finished bilging. Saw a hole of Gramps. Pump attended to.
