Tuesday August 17 First part of this day light breezes from the SW with clear weather at daylight we raise a school of Small Whales we lower three Boats we catch 12 Small Whales S-B-1-S-B-1- We take this Whales along side at 10: A.M. We commence to cutting at noon We finished cutting and we set fire pump attended to.

Wednesday August 18 First part of this day light from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under shorting sails, looking saw lots of porpoises at 6: P.M. We finished looking pump attended to.

Lat 34° 48' Long 41° 33'

Thursday August 19 First part of the day very light breeze from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack, heading ENE. We finished stow down the oil and wash the vessel in side at sun down we shorting sails pump attended to.

Lat 35° 15' Long 40° 38'

Friday August 20 First part of this day very light breeze with calm vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack, heading East, saw Whaling Bark to the windward and saw lots of porpoises we port the vessel in side pump attended to.

Lat 35° 36' Long 39° 54' West

Saturday August 21 First part of this day dead calm vessel under no sails set crew clean the vessel in side saw a Bark to the windward suppose to be Whaler, saw a lots of Grampas pump attended to.

Lat 36° 22' Long 39° 19' W

Sunday August 22 First of this day very light wind from the East with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack, Bark in side and merchants vessel bound to Eastward saw a porpoise, pump attended to.

Lat 36° 23' Long 38° 54' W

Monday August 23 First part of this day fresh breeze from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack, steering ENE. Saw a two merchant vessel bound to Eastward saw a Grampas, pump attended to.

Lat 37° 38' Long 37° 16'

Tuesday August 24 First part of this day very light wind from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading East crew clean up Reefs the vessel pump attended to.

Lat 37° 24' Long 34° 58'

Wednesday August 25 First part of this day light breeze from the SE with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading East - saw a lots of Grampas, crew scrub Iron Works and paint it pump attended to.
