Wednesday Sept 8 at St Michael with light breeze, crew employed setting up cask on watch went shore.

Send board Potatoes and fresh meat.

Thursday Sept 9 at St Michael with light wind and rain. crew setting up casks. one watch went shore.

Friday

Saturday Sept 10th this began with light breeze from Easterly, crew employed painting Iron Works and we put some cask on shore to clear up the deck. send on board fresh meat and fruits, we discharge one.

Saturday seaman, name Manuel Farter.

Sunday Sept 11 this day began with fresh breeze from the S.E. with clear weather one watch went on shore.

Monday Sept 12 this day began with light S.E. wind and clear weather. some of the crew remainder on shore no returned on board. Send board fresh meat and Potatoes.

Monday

Tuesday Sept 13 first part part of this day. Very light wind from the S.E. with clear weather, crew employed on clean the iron works.

Wednesday

Thursday Sept 14 At St Michael with light Easterly wind, crew clean up the vessel. we send some Iron Work to black smith to be fix.

Friday

Saturday September 15 at St Michael with light wind from Eastward. Bark "Platina" arrived with 650 lbs. (We discharge one seaman, name Manuel Thomas).

Sunday

Monday September 16 at St Michael with strong breezes from the S.W. - the Schooner, "Richard W. Clark" and John R. Manta, arrived.

Tuesday

Wednesday September 17 at St Michael with clear weather and very light wind, crew employed set up the rigging.

Thursday

Friday Sept 18 at St Michael with fine weather. crew went shore on watch.

Saturday

Sunday Sept 19 at St Michael with rain and calm.

Monday

Tuesday Sept 20 at St Michael with light wind from Eastward, crew employed we put some cask on shore from "R.W. Clark."

Wednesday

Thursday Sept 21 At St Michael with fine weather. crew paint on the vessel, out side and take small store from "R.W. Clark."
