Friday November 26 This day began with fresh breezes from the S E with clear weather. Crew under all sails set on Port tack head South at 4: P.M. weather got cloudy with rain - pump attended to.

No observation, sun obscure

Saturday November 27 This day began with very light breezes from the S E. Crew under all sails set on Port tack heading S by E. This day we painted the Boat outside - pump attended to.

Sunday November 28 This day began with fresh breezes from the S E with clear weather. Crew under all sails set on Port tack heading S S W - pump attended to.

Monday November 29 This day fresh breezes from the S E with cloudy weather. Crew under all sails set on Port tack, heading South. Crew making summit pump attended to. Broke one Sugar,

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Tuesday November 30 This day fresh breezes from S E with squally and rain. Crew under all sails on Port tack heading South at 6: P.M. we taking main sails set main trysails - pump attended to.

Wednesday December 1 This day fresh breezes from S E with clear weather. Crew under all sails set on Port tack heading S S W - We unbent the Flying jib to repair pump attended to.

Thursday December 2 This day strong breezes from the S E with clear atmosphere. Crew under single reef main sails, foresails and headsails on Port tack heading South. Saw a Black Fish, at 4 clock P.M. the 3rd mate and Cook start rout, Capt. stop them, pump attended to.

Lat 28:45 S Long 19:17 W

Friday December 3 This day began with fresh breezes from the S E with rough sea, on Crew under single reef main sails, foresails and head sails, on Port tack heading South by East at noon moderate wind we shrove reef out main sails, pump attended to.

Lat 30:04 S Long 18:13 W

Saturday December 4 This day began with very light wind from N W and clear atmosphere. Crew under all sails on Port tack. Steer S S E. Crew making summit pump attended to. This day we put new, main sails, haliard
