Thursday January 6 this day dead calm. Vessel under two top sails crew making sunset. Saw a Porpoise pump attended to.

Lat 15° 54' S Long 11° 47' E

Friday January 7 this day very light wind from NW with cloudy weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading SW by W. at noon we raise a school of Small Whales. We lower 3 boats. We got 8 of them. SB-4- SB-3- WB-1- We take all this Whales along side at 5th P.M. and we shorting sails pump attended to.



Lat 16° 00' S Long 11° 42' E

Saturday January 8 this day very light wind with calm. At daylight we put gear up, and commence to cutting at 6th P.M. we finished cutting in and we clear up the deck and start the fire-pump attended to, land in sight.

Lat 16° 01' S Long 11° 40' E

Sunday January 9 this day light westerly wind with clear weather. Vessel under main sails and head sails on Port tack heading NW by W. We hoisting at sunset we shorting sails pump attended to, land in sight no observation.

Monday January 10 this day light breezes from SE with clear weather. Vessel under main sails and head sails hoisting on Starboard tack. Saw lots of porpoises at sunset took in mainsail set main top sails pump attended to.

Lat 16° 03' S Long 11° 32' E

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Tuesday January 11 this day fresh breeze from SE with clear atmosphere. Vessel under main sail and head sails on Starboard tack heading South. Saw a finback at 6th P.M. We pick up a dead Whale and we shorting sails pump attended to.

Lat 16° 12' S Long 11° 00' E

Wednesday January 12 this day very light breezes from SE with clear weather in morning we put gear up, and we commence to cutting whale at 6th A.M. we finished cutting and we took gear down. Vessel under shorting on Port tack hoisting. We put some oil down pump attended to. Saw a dead whale to windward this not good.

Lat 16° 17' S Long 11° 32' E

Thursday January 13 this day began with light breeze from SE with clear weather, in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack heading SE by E at 10th A.M. the Capt went aboard of bark "Grayhound" at 3th P.M. we raised a school of Small Whales. We lower three and "Grayhound" lower four we got one small whale "Grayhound" Boat at sunset we shorting sails pump attended to.

Lat 16° 26' S Long 11° 28' E

Friday January 14 this day dead calm all day. We lower down for Black Fish. We got 5. SB-2- WB-1- SB-2- at 3th 30 P.M. the Capt went on board of Bark "Grayhound" and returned at 6th P.M. we stand to Westward pump attended to, no observation this day sunset require =
