Wednesday January 26 This day began with fresh breeze from SW in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack heading S E, saw a Finback, crew making sextant at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.
 Lat 16.00 S Long 11.12 E

Thursday January 27 This day began with fresh breeze from SW and hazy atmosphere. Crew under all sails set on Port tack - cruising saw a humpback at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.
 Lat 16.18 S Long 11.37 E

Friday January 28 This day began with moderate wind from SW and atmosphere hazy in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack at noon we raised a three small whales going to windward quick we could not head them at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Saturday January 29 This day began with fresh breeze from SW and hazy atmosphere. Crew under all sails set on Starboard tack cruising at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.
 Lat 16.14 S Long 11.30 E

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Sunday January 30 This day began with moderate breeze from SE with clear weather, at 6^h A.M. we raised a school of small whale, we lower three Boats, we caught one - S. B. at 9^h A.M. we take this whale along side and we got gear up start to cutting in at noon we finished and we took gear down and clear up the head and start fire at 6^h P.M. we take in main sail set main trysails pump attended to.

Monday January 31 This day began with very strong wind from SW with rough sea and atmosphere clear. Crew under shorting sails, at 6^h A.M. we finished boiling pump attended to.

Lat 16.03 S Long 11.04 E

Tuesday February 1 This day began with strong breeze from SW and rough sea, clear weather we stow down oil and wash the vessel in side, at 4^h P.M. we raised a school of small whale, we lower three Boats we caught 4 small whales loss 3 and save one S. B. at 9^h A.M. we take the Boats and hoist up and we got up fire, pump attended to.

Lat 16.12 S Long 10.47 E

Wednesday February 2 This day began with moderate wind and smooth sea at daylight we commenced to cut at 9^h P.M. we finished and took gear down and we made sails standing on wind on Port tack at sun set we shorting sails, saw a Finback pump attended to.
