Monday February 14 This day strong wind from SW with clear weather and rough sea on vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack standing on windward crew making Sennet pumps attended to

Tuesday February 15 This day began with very light wind from SW and clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading S & E - crew making Sennet at sun set shorting sails, and wore ship on Port tack pumps attended to

Wednesday February 16 This day fresh breeze with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack crew making Sennet at 4th P.M. we sighted the land at 5th P.M. we wore ship on Port tack and we shorting sails pumps attended to

Thursday February 17 This day light wind with cloudy weather at 10th P.M. hazy saw a lot of porpoise vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading S & E at 6: P.M. we shorting sails pumps attended to no observation sun beque

Sunday February 20 This day, first part dead calm later part fresh breeze, we made sails on Starboard tack running off stern N & E at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Lat 15° 56' S Long 11° 21' E

Monday February 21 This day very light wind from SW with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack saw a black at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Lat 15° 40' S Long 10° 57' E

Tuesday February 22 This day light wind from SW with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Port tack standing on windward we spoke to "Grayhound" with 5-50 barrels oil at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Lat 15° 20' S Long 11° 29' E

Wednesday February 23 This day very light wind with calm vessel under all sails set on Port tack at noon wore ship on Starboard tack "Grayhound" in sight at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Lat 15° 00' S Long 11° 31' E

Thursday February 24 This day dead calm with clear atmosphere vessel under no sails set pumps attended to - "Grayhound" in sight
